Your GCSE Maths summer 2023 exams will take place on the following dates:

**GCSE English Summer 2023 Exam Dates**

**Paper 1 (non-calculator):** arrive at 8.00am – Friday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2023

**Paper 2 (calculator):** arrive at 8.00am – Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2023

**Paper 3 (calculator):** arrive at 8.00am – Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2023

You have done all your revision and studied hard to get here, so please read the guidance and advice below.

**NOTE: These are national exam dates and cannot be changed or sat at another time/or date so please make sure you do not miss these exams.**

**Before the exam:**

- Please make sure you check the seating plan for the exam and that you know the exam **room number** for your exam. Seating plans will be displayed outside the Exams Office in the Atrium for you to check.
- Prepare the **essential equipment** you need to bring in with you: two or three black pens, a pencil, a pencil sharpener, a rubber, a scientific calculator (PAPERS 2 & 3 ONLY), a ruler, a protractor, a compass, your statement of entry, your college ID and a bottle of water.
- **Mobile phones** and other **similar portable devices** are NOT allowed in the exam room. Best advice – leave them at home. You must leave any phones or devices at the collection desks in the Atrium. You are not allowed to take these into the exam room.

**On the exam day:**

- Ensure you are appropriately dressed for the exam: No hats or coats must be worn during the exam duration and in the exam rooms. If the weather is cold please wear suitable layers.
- Arrive at the college at **8.00AM**. Getting here early will also give you some breathing space to relax before you go into the exam room.
- Register at the sign-in desk in the Atrium.
